All of our training is trauma informed as a basis for understanding vulnerability and behaviour and provides a framework approach. Training is designed to be experiential, engaging and participative in approach and focusses on increasing personal insight and the development of skills rather than simply raise awareness.

We see foster carers as the frontline for vulnerable kids and we love working with them. We recognise that carers don't always get access to the level of training that other professionals in the field do, because of their caring duties. Our **carer days** of training take place between 10am and 2pm, allowing for the school run and other important tasks.
